【英語】

2021 年度 公立高校入学試験 出題範囲変更に伴う補強問題

入試の出題範囲の変更に伴い、従来は入試頻出であった分野や領域から出題がされなくなり、今年に限り違う傾向の問題や、別の分野や領域が入試の目玉となる可能性があります。それらに対応するための「補強問題」をご用意いたしました。

英語は文法事項の出題範囲変更がほとんどですが、削除される関係代名詞、分詞、間接疑問文、tell[want など]+人+to不定詞を含まない長文問題は入試ではほぼ出題されませんので、過去問を使って対策をすることが難しいため上記の文法事項を含まない長文読解問題をご用意いたしました。入試の範囲に合わせて、総仕上げとしてご利用ください。



Hello, everyone. I asked 150 students, 50 students in each *grade, "Who do you want to spend your weekends with?" I wanted them to answer the question. They *chose "friends," "family," "*alone" or "others" as their answers. Look at the graph.

More than *half of the first-grade students chose "friends." 20 (*)-grade students also chose "friends." They think it is fun to play sports and go shopping with their friends. We usually think this is true for *teenagers, but I found it was not for the third-grade students. 16 of them chose "friends," but more chose "alone," and they were about half of the third-grade students. I asked them why they chose "alone." Then, many of them said they had to study for *entrance exams. I was sad to hear that, because I am a (*)-grade student and will take an entrance exam next year.

The number of the students choosing "family" was the smallest. It is *surprising to me. I go to a lot of places with my family.

There were some students choosing "others." All of them said they were their pets. *At first, I didn't think they *understood my question, but now I can say that for these students, their pets are like their friends and their families.
